

# Request for Speed Limit Reduction Esperance Coast Road Little Roaring Beach

## Background

Council has received three requests to reinstate 40 km/h speed signs at the settlement of Little Roaring Beach and one request to review the default speed limit on Esperance Coast Road which is 100 km/h.

Investigations with Department of State Growth indicate 40 km/h speed signs were not installed at Little Roaring Beach (see drawing HV/8/24(G) attached). There is however 25 km/h and 35 km/h advisory signs installed at the settlement extents.

### Key issues

Esperance Coast Road is classified as a "distributor" road within Huon Valley Council's GIS system. It provides connection from Huon Highway along the coast to Dover.

The entire length of Esperance Coast Road (19.011 km) is regulated by the default speed limit for sealed roads which is 100 km/h.

A traffic counter was deployed to Esperance Coast Road Little Roaring Beach from 22 November 2018 to 6 December, 2018 - a period of two weeks. Council Officers have run the data using 100 km/h and the requested 40 km/h speeds. A copy of the report is attached however a summary of salient points is below:-

At the posted speed of 100 km/h there were no instances of the speed limit being exceeded, in fact the median speed is listed at 39.3 km/h.

At the suggested speed limit of 40 km/h 45.88 percent of traffic was speeding, with the median speed remaining a 39.3 km/h.
