

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE BY-LAW MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS BY-LAW 2021

Council has resolved to make the Miscellaneous Amendments By-law - No. 1 of 2021.

The purpose of the proposed By-law is to make a number of minor amendments to the *Waste Management By-law 2012*, the *Caravan By-law 2015* and the *Council Land and Recreational Facilities By-law 2017*. No Regulatory Impact Statement has been prepared as provided under section 156A of the *Local Government Act 1993*.

The Primary objectives of the proposed By-law are to:

- Ensure that the By-laws to be amended are consistent with current legislation and remain appropriately enforceable;
- Provide clarification arising from unintended consequences from the By-laws as originally drafted; and to
- Take into account changing expectations and needs of the community associated with dealing with homeless persons and use of Council land and tracks for animals.

The envisaged or potential impact and the primary features of the proposed By-law affecting the community or groups within the community are:

- Users of Council's public marine facilities will benefit by clarifying the restriction of individuals being able to moor at Council facilities for no more than two consecutive nights;
- Persons who may set up camp on Council land will have a defence to an offence of camping without a permit if they can demonstrate at the time they set up camp they were homeless.
