

How to find your Local Provision Schedule information online

1. Access the mapping portal, input the address of the site you want to review.

2. Take note of the zone applied to the property.

Unselect the 'zones' layer and select each of the code layers.

Take note of the codes applied to the property and where they are located.

Unselect all code layers and select 'General overlays'.

Take note of any Specific Area Plans, Site Specific Qualifications or Local Area Objectives that apply to the property.

- 3a. Access the State Planning Provisions (SPP) and review the zone use table, use, development, and subdivision standards.

- 3b. Access the current Huon Valley Interim Planning Scheme 2015 (HVIPS 2015) if you would like to compare differences between your current and future proposed zone.

- 4a. Go to the relevant codes in the SPPs (page 297 onwards) and review the provisions within each of the codes that apply to the property.

- 4b. If you would like to compare the new SPPs with those currently included in the HVIPS 2015, use the link in 3b. above to access the interim scheme. Please note you cannot make a representation on the provisions contained within the new State Planning Provisions codes, only on whether a code should apply to a particular area.

5. Access the Huon Valley Local Provisions Schedule and review the provisions of any Specific Area Plan, Site Specific Qualifications, or Local Area Objectives that apply to the property.
