Huon Valley is stepping up to Clean Up Australia Day 2023

Clean Up Australia Day is the nation's largest community-based environmental event.

A range of local Huon Valley community, school and youth groups conduct clean-ups annually to beautify local spaces and remove litter from the environment.

Last year Huon Valley Council was one of 11 Tasmanian councils taking part in the event.

“Clean Up Australia Day is a great opportunity to work together and take practical action,” Huon Valley Council Mayor Sally Doyle said.

“We seek the support of all community members and community groups. Together we can tackle litter and create a positive impact on local natural and urban areas.”

Council will provide full support for registered events and can assist by selecting an appropriate site and offering free disposal of collected litter at any Council waste transfer station.

“We encourage groups of all types to get involved in this event, including schools, businesses, sporting clubs and community groups.”



Clean up Australia day will be taking place on Sunday 5 March 2023. Business Clean Up Day will be on Tuesday 28 February and Schools Clean Up Day on Friday 3 March.
